
SCHOOL CLOSED

CELEBRATION OF LIGHT - Thursday, October 31, 2024

In keeping with this year's spiritual theme, "Living, Celebrating and Proclaiming Our Faith," with a focus on **Celebrating**, we ask students to think about the many ways people celebrate and choose a costume/outfit that reflects **Celebrating**.

For example: clowns, cheerleaders, individuals in parades (Disney characters, marching band, gymnasts, baton twirlers, police officers, firefighters etc.), religious, traditional/cultural outfits, concerts, performers, etc. Students may also come to school dressed in their favourite fall colours.

TRAFFIC/PARKING LOT SAFETY

Regulations in the parking lot are in place to ensure the safety of the children. It is essential that parents follow the instructions of staff and yard supervisors on duty. Parents are expected to follow instructions respectfully and comply.

Be aware of residents parked on Nanaimo Street who need to merge. Please stop and allow them access to Nanaimo Street.

SCHOOL ZONE SPEED LIMIT

DO NOT SPEED in school parking lot (15 km/h), along Nanaimo St. and Waverley Ave. (30 km/h) Parents must use caution for vehicles exiting the parking lot from Waverley Ave.

School Zone hours: 8:00 AM - 5:00 PM

Speed Limit: 30 km/h

Speeding in a School Zone Fine: \$196 to \$483

Schools and playgrounds

147 (1)A person driving a vehicle on a regular school day and on a highway where signs are displayed stating a speed limit of 30 km/h, or on which the numerals "30" are prominently shown, must drive at a rate of speed not exceeding 30 km/h while approaching or passing the school building and school grounds to which the signs relate, between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m., or subject to subsection (1.1), between any extended times that are stated on the signs.

(1.1) Extended times under subsection (1) may not begin later than 8 a.m. or end earlier than 5 p.m. (2)A person driving a vehicle on a highway must drive the vehicle at a rate of speed not exceeding 30 km/h when approaching or passing, between dawn and dusk, a public playground for children where signs are displayed stating a speed limit of 30 km/h, or on which the numerals "30" are prominently shown.

PARKING BYLAWS

Do not park on the wrong side of the road and or double park.

Not only is it illegal and warrants a ticket, but it is also dangerous. Please respect traffic laws, the children and their families.

- 19.1 An owner, registered owner, lessee or operator of a vehicle must not cause, allow or permit that vehicle to stop on a lane:
- (e) opposite to or in close proximity to another vehicle already stopped in the lane in such manner as to obstruct the free movement of other vehicles.
